

JASON WOODS (EVERYONE) is a stage, film, and voiceover actor based out of northern Florida. Frequently seen on stage in area theatres, he has enjoyed the opportunity to perform and is never one to shy away from a challenge. Most recently at Theatre Jacksonville he was tasked with portraying the polar opposite father/son duo in *Old Love*. Other past credits include The Hatter in *Alice in Wonderland*, Thomas Cromwell in *Wolf Hall* and Ludwig Van Beethoven in 33 *Variations*. He performs another solo stage performance of *A Christmas Carol*, now in its 10th year. He is also a writer/director/composer, with credits that include his original works *St. George & the Dragon, Mr. Toad's Wild Expedition*, and *Peter Pan*. CREATING DURING A PANDEMIC

In the past decade I have had the privilege of working as a producer, writer, composer, actor, director, and designer for theatrical shows in Northeast Florida. The response and opportunities yielded from my work has been heartening. Even though the pandemic of 2020 closed the doors to live theatre, I developed ways to continue live productions online to enable creative experiences for actors both in our community and those in other states through presentations of Storytime with Jason Woods on Facebook.



In early 2021, I reengaged my goals in performance, production, and creative engagement, and I moved forward with this new play. The Near-Disaster of Jasper and Casper is a comedic fantasy with themes of family, loss, self-discovery, and reconciliation; portraying ten characters and composing a cinematic score for the production allowed me to focus my creative energies these past few months.



The workshop phase of The Near Disaster of Jasper and Casper means it is time to finalize the script, work with a director; create distinct physical and vocal techniques for the ten characters, commit the 40-page script to memory, and score musical cues. The capacity, time, and energy required for all of these disciplines is extraordinary, and the support provided by Michelle Kindy and Theatre Jacksonville has been instrumental in facilitating its development.

This play has been accepted to be performed at the United Solo Festival in London's West End, and New York City's 42nd Street Theatre Row in the fall of this year. These invitations are not only an honor, they near dream fulfilment, as many of my performance inspirations come from the U.K. Both opportunities from United Solo will expand my artistic orbit in new and meaningful ways.

But regardless where this show takes me, nothing is better than playing to a hometown crowd, even when they are through the looking glass and in the comfort of their own homes!
